A fitting response

Colossians 1:15-20 (ESV)

- 15 **He** is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.
- 16 For by **Him** all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities – all things were created through **Him** and for **Him**.

17 And **He** is before all things, and in **Him** all things hold together.

18 And **He** is the head of the body, the church.

He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything **He** might be preeminent.

19 For in **Him** all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through **Him** to reconcile to Himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of **His** cross.
